OLD TESTAMENT READING: Daniel 10:10–14; 12:1–3 EPISTLE READING: Revelation 12:7–12 HOLY GOSPEL: *Matthew* 18:1–11

Our Father in Heaven Protects His Children by Giving His Holy Angels Charge Over Them

We live in "*a time of trouble*" (Dan. 12:1), in the midst of great tribulation. Satan and his wicked angels have been thrown out of heaven and have come down to earth "*in great wrath*," with woeful "*temptations to sin*" and with constant accusations (Rev. 12:8–12; Matt. 18:7).
